SWITZERLAND: AGREEMENT FOR MEDICAL DEVICES NOT ACHIEVED



Switzerland has decided not to renew the MRA (Mutual recognition agreement) with the EU and will therefore be considered a third state. Therefore, there will also be repercussions on the new MDR Regulation, which entered into force on May 26, 2021.

The Mutual Recognition Agreement (MRA) is one of the key agreements between the EU and Switzerland that facilitate bilateral trade in different sectors, including medical devices. The EU has proposed to Switzerland as a precautionary measure a limited amendment to the medical devices chapter of the MRA which provides for a transitional period of validity for existing devices with Swiss certificates until May 26th, 2024, and the same transitional validity for certificates issued in 'EU. Despite constant efforts and the EU's readiness to conclude this transitional agreement, the proposed modification was not achieved.

ECHA: EVALUATION OF THE CURRENT CONCENTRATION LIMITS FOR CADMIUM IN RECYCLED PVC



The restriction provides for a generic limit value of 0.01% weight by weight for cadmium compounds. However, some applications containing recycled PVC are allowed on the market with a concentration value greater than 0.1% w / w.

ECHA proposes that the limit value associated with the derogation could be reduced to 0.08% w / w without major impact on current recycling rates or costs to industry. However, reducing the limit would not significantly improve product safety or environmental protection and any potential decrease in recycling, due to a tighter limit, could actually lead to an increase in environmental pollution in the short term.

PHILIPPINES ADDED 52 CHEMICALS TO THE PICCS LIST



On May 24, 2021, the Philippine Environmental Management Bureau under the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR-EMB) published a memorandum entitled 2021 Updated Philippine Inventory of Chemicals and Chemical Substances (PICCS), where 52 new substances are added at 22,277 already present. The PICCS is a list of all existing chemicals and chemicals used, sold, distributed, imported, processed, manufactured, stored, exported, treated or transported to the Philippines.

Chemicals that are not listed in the PICCS will be considered as new chemicals in the Philippines and their manufacturers or importers will have to submit a Prefabrication and Pre-Import Notification (PMPIN) to the DENR-EMB to obtain an authorization. In contrast, for chemicals listed in the PICCS, manufacturers or importers will be exempted from the notification requirement as long as those substances are not on the Priority Chemicals List (PCL) or subject to chemical control orders (CCO).

KKIDIK (TURKISH REACH): LATE PREREGISTRATION ACCEPTED BY TURKISH AUTORITHY ONLY EARLY 2021

ACT NOW IF YOU LOST THE LAST DEADLINE



In 2017, Turkey published and consolidated the text of the KKIDIK regulation regarding chemicals that can be placed on local national market. The scheme adopted follows the European REACH regulation in many prescriptions, so much so that it is often referred to as Turkey-REACH.

One of the significant differences is that there is only one registration deadline for all tonnage bands, set for 31/12/2023.

At this stage, the possibility is open to pre-register by 31/12/2020 but the Turkish government seems to accept late preregistration until 31.12.2023.

Moreover, in the last quarter of 2021 The MoEU will add a sub-tool into the KKS in order to generate Chemical Safety Report.

As for REACH EU, applicants must be Turkish legal entities. Non-Turkish companies that want to keep the market will have to appoint a local OR (only Representative). RNI srl can offer this service.

SEA UPDATES:

The SEA CLP like Regulation has been updated, adding 110 new substances to the Harmonized List of classification and labeling "and new hazard classifications. Furthermore, only polymers must be notified and not their ingredients.
