ECHA: BIOCIDES COMMITTEE PROPOSES NOT TO APPROVE FOUR SILVER-CONTAINING ACTIVE SUBSTANCES



ECHA's Biocidal Products Committee (BPC) concluded that the assessment of the following active substances does not support their approval for PT4 (food and feed area):

- silver zinc zeolite:
- · silver zeolite;
- silver copper zeolite; and
- silver sodium hydrogen zirconium phosphate.

For these existing active substances, the committee concluded that the risks are unacceptable for human health when activated carbon water filters with silver-containing active substances are used. People may be exposed through drinking water or food which has been prepared in filtered water.

The BPC also adopted a positive opinion on an application for Union authorisation of a biocidal product family based on peracetic acid in PT 2 (disinfectants and algaecides not intended for direct application to humans or animals), 3 (veterinary hygiene) and 4 (food and feed area).

AUSTRALIA SWA AND 168 WORKPLACE EXPOSURE STANDARDS



In early February 2021, Safe Work Australia (SWA), Australia's top body for work health and safety, opened a public consultation on the remaining 168 workplace exposure standards (WESs) for airborne contaminants. Comments are set to close on July 30 this year. Currently, SWA is evaluating the WESs for airborne contaminants to ensure the standards are developed based on high-quality evidence and supported by a rigorous scientific approach.

Comments are related to two aspects:

- · the toxicological information and data that the recommended SWE value is based upon, and
- the measurement and analysis information provided.

The evaluation results will contribute to the development of a list of health-based recommendations for the WESs in the country.

EUROPEAN COMMISSION AND CHANGE ON INTERMEDIATES CRITERIA OF REACH



The European Commission will consider making changes to REACH on the definition of intermediate uses, which aims to mirror new criteria set out in a court ruling for substances used in production processes.

The strategy includes changes to the legal text on intermediates, referred to in Article 3 (15), he said in his document released at the meeting of the competent authorities for REACH and CLP on 3-4 March.

The Court of Justice ruling in 2017 on the SVHC acrylamide indicated three criteria that intermediates must simultaneously fulfil, prompting Echa to propose revisions to its existing guidance.

The first criterion on intermediates in the updated guidance will now remove the need for the 'main' purpose of use to be the transformation of a substance into another; instead the second and the third are the technical means by which the transformation takes place, known as synthesis; and the confinement to a controlled environment.

KKIDIK (TURKISH REACH): LATE PREREGISTRATION ACCEPTED BY TURKISH AUTORITHY ONLY EARLY 2021

ACT NOW IF YOU LOST THE LAST DEADLINE



In 2017, Turkey published and consolidated the text of the KKIDIK regulation regarding chemicals that can be placed on local national market. The scheme adopted follows the European REACH regulation in many prescriptions, so much so that it is often referred to as Turkey-REACH.

One of the significant differences is that there is only one registration deadline for all tonnage bands, set for 31/12/2023.

At this stage, the possibility is open to pre-register by 31/12/2020 but the Turkish government seems to accept late preregistration until 31.12.2023.

Moreover, in the last quarter of 2021 The MoEU will add a sub-tool into the KKS in order to generate Chemical Safety Report.

As for REACH EU, applicants must be Turkish legal entities. Non-Turkish companies that want to keep the market will have to appoint a local OR (only Representative). RNI srl can offer this service.

SEA UPDATES:

The SEA CLP like Regulation has been updated, adding 110 new substances to the Harmonized List of classification and labeling "and new hazard classifications. Furthermore, only polymers must be notified and not their ingredients.
