This choice is one of the objectives to be achieved in order to have "zero pollution", a central ambition of the EU's Green Deal commitment.

The Green Deal is a new growth strategy that aims to transform the EU into a fair and prosperous society, with a modern, resource-efficient and competitive economy by 2050. A system where there will be no net emissions of greenhouse gases and where economic growth is totally independent of the use of resources.

ECHA actively participates in the "The EU's Chemicals Strategy for Sustainability" program to drive innovation and propose new sustainable alternatives.

OPEN CONSULTATIONS ON CHROMIUM (VI) AUTHORIZATIONS

From 21 October 2020, consultations on the substitustion plans of four applications for authorization of the use of hexavalent chromium, a substance of extremely high concern, are open.

ECHA's Committee for Socio-Economic Analysis (SEAC) will evaluate the plans and information received from the consultation for a scientific basis for the European Commission to decide whether or not to grant authorizations

The consultation period lasts 4 weeks, you have time to send comments until November 18, 2020.

VIETNAM: NATIONAL CHEMICAL INVENTORY (NCI) REGISTRATION SYSTEM HAS BEEN REOPENED



On October 16, 2020, the Vietnamese Chemical Agencies, under the Ministry of Industry and Commerce (MOIT), issued a notice informing companies that the National Chemical Inventory (NCI) registration system has been reopened. Companies can submit information on chemicals that have been imported, manufactured and used in Vietnam until April 15, 2021.

After review, the chemicals submitted can be included in the NCI.

KKIDIK (TURKISH REACH): PREREGISTRATION DEADLINE SET ON 31/12/2020.



In 2017, Turkey published and consolidated the text of the KKIDIK regulation regarding chemicals that can be placed on local national market. The scheme adopted follows the European REACH regulation in many prescriptions, so much so that it is often referred to as Turkey-REACH. One of the significant differences is that there is only one registration deadline for all tonnage bands, set for 31/12/2023.

At this stage, the possibility is open to pre-register by 31/12/2020.

As for REACH EU, applicants must be Turkish legal entities. Non-Turkish companies that want to keep the market will have to appoint a local OR (only Representative). RNI srl can offer this service.
