ECHA: CONTROL OF CONSUMER PRODUCTS AND BIOCIDES IN 2022



The REF-10 will focus on integrated controls on consumer products such as the presence of POPs or PFOAs or the presence of REACH restricted substances.

Instead for biocides (BEF-2), the inspection will cover biocides with approved and non-approved active ingredients. The controls will cover all types of biocidal products and will include both products already authorized under the BPR and products covered by parts of national biocidal product legislation.

The REF-10 and BEF-2 projects will both be prepared in 2021, with inspections carried out in 2022 and reports to be published in 2023.

### CLP: CLASSIFICATION PROPOSAL FOR ENDOCRINE DISRUPTORS



The European Commission proposes that endocrine disrupting chemicals (EDCs) be classified in CLP as "category 1: known or presumed" or "category 2: suspected". The draft proposal, which will be discussed with Member States at the next meeting of the Subgroup of Competent Authorities on Endocrine Disruption (CASG-ED) on 22 March, is an important step in in changing CLP to account for EDCs, as required by the chemicals strategy. Two new hazard classes will be created: Endocrine Disruption Affecting Human Health (ED HH) and Endocrine Disruption Affecting the Environment (ED ENV). In both cases, the classification would be divided into two categories, partially reflecting the already existing structure for substances that are carcinogenic, mutagenic or toxic for reproduction (CMR).

Industry has pushed back against the idea of creating new hazard classes for the substances, saying that any risks posed should be controlled through REACH, rather than CLP. Additionally, there are concerns about perceived divergence between CLP and the Globally Harmonized System for classification and labelling of chemicals (GHS).

## EFSA: GUIDELINES FOR THE PREPARATION OF APPLICATIONS ON RECYCLING PROCESSES



# **European Food Safety Authority**

This document provides guidance to applicants submitting applications on recycling processes to produce recycled plastic materials and articles intended to come into contact with food, which are to be evaluated by EFSA. It describes the administrative requirements for the preparation and online submission of the dossier to support an application for a new authorisation or for the modification of an existing authorisation of recycling processes to produce recycled plastic materials and articles intended to come into contact with food, for applications submitted to the competent authority of a Member State as of 27 March 2021.

The guidance describes the procedure and the associated timelines for handling applications on recycling processes, the different possibilities to interact with EFSA and the support initiatives available from the preparation of the application (pre-submission phase) to the adoption and publication of EFSA's scientific opinion.

## KKIDIK (TURKISH REACH): LATE PREREGISTRATION ACCEPTED BY TURKISH AUTORITHY ONLY EARLY 2021

### **ACT NOW IF YOU LOST THE LAST DEADLINE**



In 2017, Turkey published and consolidated the text of the KKIDIK regulation regarding chemicals that can be placed on local national market. The scheme adopted follows the European REACH regulation in many prescriptions, so much so that it is often referred to as Turkey-REACH.

One of the significant differences is that there is only one registration deadline for all tonnage bands, set for 31/12/2023.

At this stage, the possibility is open to pre-register by 31/12/2020 but the Turkish government seems to accept late preregistration until 31.12.2023.

Moreover, in the last quarter of 2021 The MoEU will add a sub-tool into the KKS in order to generate Chemical Safety Report.

As for REACH EU, applicants must be Turkish legal entities. Non-Turkish companies that want to keep the market will have to appoint a local OR (only Representative). RNI srl can offer this service.

### **SEA UPDATES:**

The SEA CLP like Regulation has been updated, adding 110 new substances to the Harmonized List of classification and labeling "and new hazard classifications. Furthermore, only polymers must be notified and not their ingredients.
