SWITZERLAND AND UFI CODES



From 1 January 2022, the UFI code will be mandatory for all preparations placed on the Swiss market for consumer use. It is therefore necessary to report the ECHA UFI code on the label and in section 1.1 of the safety data sheet of the following preparations and to notify them to the Chemical Products Registry:

- Preparations imported from the EEA.
- Preparations which are placed on the market in Switzerland, but which are also exported to the EEA.


The use of ECHA's UFI generator is intended for EEA-based companies only. However, Switzerland recognizes an EEA generated UFI for PCN notifications. The CH generator, on the other hand, should only be used for preparations which are placed on the market in Switzerland but not in the EEA, and which are classified as dangerous due to physical or health hazards.

The obligation to indicate the UFI for preparations, biocides and fertilizers classified as dangerous due to physical or health hazards, has the following transitional terms:

- for new preparations, biocides and fertilizers placed on the market for consumer use: from 1 January 2022;
 for preparations, biocides and fertilizers already equipped with UFI: from 1 January 2022. This category includes in particular products imported from the EEA. The additional obligation to announce a product equipped with UFI aims to ensure that Tox Info Suisse can find its formula in the Swiss Chemicals Register
- for all other preparations, biocides and fertilizers classified as dangerous due to physical or health hazards: from 1 January 2026.

CHINA AND THE AIR TRANSPORT OF DANGEROUS GOODS



On March 30, 2021, the Civil Aviation Administration of China (CACC) published the 2021 List of Dangerous Goods for Air Transport which replaced the 2019 version. Common Dangerous Goods in Air Transport can be divided into three groups based on aviation safety requirements:

- dangerous goods of group 1 sorted by UN code or ID numbers,
- dangerous goods of group 2, goods not carrying the UN numbers and which can be transported by air if they meet certain requirements.
- dangerous goods of group 3 are always prohibited in air transport (e.g. explosive substances).

JAPAN: REVISION OF LAWS ON CHEMICAL SUBSTANCES IN THE WORKPLACE



The Japanese Ministry of Health and Welfare (MHLW) met on April 27, 2021 with the aim of discussing the regulations governing chemicals in the workplace and the probable revision of the provisions concerning workplace safety.

KKIDIK (TURKISH REACH): LATE PREREGISTRATION ACCEPTED BY TURKISH AUTORITHY ONLY EARLY 2021

ACT NOW IF YOU LOST THE LAST DEADLINE



In 2017, Turkey published and consolidated the text of the KKIDIK regulation regarding chemicals that can be placed on local national market. The scheme adopted follows the European REACH regulation in many prescriptions, so much so that it is often referred to as Turkey-REACH.

One of the significant differences is that there is only one registration deadline for all tonnage bands, set for 31/12/2023.

At this stage, the possibility is open to pre-register by 31/12/2020 but the Turkish government seems to accept late preregistration until 31.12.2023.

Moreover, in the last quarter of 2021 The MoEU will add a sub-tool into the KKS in order to generate Chemical Safety Report.

As for REACH EU, applicants must be Turkish legal entities. Non-Turkish companies that want to keep the market will have to appoint a local OR (only Representative). RNI srl can offer this service.

SEA UPDATES:

The SEA CLP like Regulation has been updated, adding 110 new substances to the Harmonized List of classification and labeling "and new hazard classifications. Furthermore, only polymers must be notified and not their ingredients.
